
Praying after tayammum then water becomes available

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بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

Questioner: A man is praying having performed dry-ablution [tayammum], and then during the prayer water becomes available, what should he do?

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ)¹: He cuts off his prayer, and uses the water [to perform wudoo].

Questioner: Okay, what if he has given the tasleem and then water becomes available? After he had given the tasleem? [i.e., after he has completed his prayer?]

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ): Khalaas ...

Questioner: Sorry?

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ): Thus is the case judged concerning which you both did inquire. His prayer is correct, but he must perform wudoo for the next one.²
