Questioner: O Shaykh of ours! Actually I don't remember (maybe it's in) the hadeeth about, 'The one who prayed badly,' that in some of its paths of narration, he (صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ) said, "When you stand to pray, then give the call to prayer, then stand, then say, 'Allaahu Akbar.'"

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ)2: Yes, this is in Sunan Abu Dawud, authenticated.

Questioner: And it is authentic?

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ): Yes.

Questioner: And this is something which confirms that the adhaan is prescribed for the person who prays alone and the one who doesn't [pray alone but prays in a Jamaa'ah]?

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ): Yes.³
