بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

From Anas, (rad iyallaahu `anhu)¹ “When he (صلى الله عليه وسلم)² would strive in supplicating for someone he would say:

جَعَلَ اللَّهُ عَلَيْكُمْ صَلَاةَ قَوْمٍ أَبْرَارٍ، يَفُومُونَ اللَّيْلَ وَيَصُومُونَ النَّهَارَ، نَيْسُوا بِأَثْمَةٍ وَلَا فُجَّارٍ

Ja'alallāhu 'alaikum ṣalāta qowmin abrār, yaqūmūnal-laila wa yaṣūmūna-nahāra laisū bi athamatin wa lā fujjār

*'May Allaah cause to be over you the prayers of a righteous people who stand [in prayer] at night and fast during the day, and who are neither sinners nor wicked evil-doers.'*³
