

The incident that directed Shaykh al-Albaanee towards the Science of Hadeeth

"Imaam al-Albaanee grew up in Damascus, Syria. In his youth the state the Ummah had reached alarmed and greatly disturbed him: [its] ignorance, myths/superstitions, blind following, innovations, misguidance, in fact polytheism and idol worship, and he used to renounce it. A Shaykh heard him forbidding some wrong and so said to him, 'Haven't you heard the hadeeth of the Prophet (صلى الله عليه وسلم)¹, "Leave the people in their heedlessness?"

Al-Albaanee, still a youth, replied, "Who reported this hadeeth? And what is its grading?" The Shaykh was taken aback by this youth and was unable, naturally, to answer him.

So al-Albaanee went and started to delve deeply into books, checking, researching, scrutinising until Allaah, the Mighty and Majestic, guided him to the hadeeth with its complete wording, "Leave the people to their heedlessness, they are granted provision [by Allaah] one from another," and so he checked it and expounded upon the condition of its narrators and made known its grading.

So Shaykh al-Albaanee told me one time that this was the beginning of his work in this noble [field of] knowledge."
