## Taken from 'Silsilah Ahadeeth As-Saheehah'

No. 1095 – From Aboo Rashid al-Hubraanee who said: Aboo Umama al-Bahilee (رضي الله عنه)<sup>1</sup> took me by the hand and said: the Messenger of Allaah (صلى الله عليه وسلم)<sup>2</sup> took me by my hand and said to me: **'O Aboo Umama! Indeed from the believers are those who soften (with love) their hearts towards me.'**<sup>3</sup>

Shaykh Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ) said:

And the meaning of **'soften their hearts towards me'** is that they are gentle and incline towards me with love and affection and Allaah knows best. And this cannot be achieved except with *Ikhlaas* (sincerity) and following the Messenger (صلى الله عليه وسلم) more than any other human being, because Allaah (عزوجل)<sup>5</sup> singled that out as an evidence to prove that a person really loves Allaah (عزوجل)<sup>6</sup>.

Allaah said: [Say (O Muhammad): 'If you (really) love Allaah then follow me, Allaah will love you and forgive you of your sins.]<sup>7</sup>

Is it not about time that those who claim to love the Messenger (صلى الله عليه وسلم) in their speech and their *an-Nasheed* (songs), that they return to adhere to the true love which will lead to the love of Allaah (تعالى), so that they will not be from those whom, the poet said:

تعصى الإله وأنتَ تُظهرُ حُبَّه مُ \*\*\* هذا لَعَمْرُكَ في القياس بديع ُ لو كانَ حُبُكَ صادقا ً لأطعت مه \*\*\* إنَّ المحب لمنْ يُحبُ مُطيع ُ

You disobey your Lord and present your love \*\*\* I swear that this action is innovative If your love was truthful you would have obeyed Him \*\*\* Indeed the one who loves is obedient to the one whom he loves
