Merit of supplicating during last hour on Friday

Concerning the merit of supplicating during last hour on Friday and the agreement of the Companions regarding that

"The Prophet (صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ) said, 'Friday is divided into twelve hours. Amongst them there is an hour in which a Muslim does not ask Allaah for anything but He gives it to him. So seek it in the last hour after the afternoon ['Asr] prayer.'2

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ الله)³ said, 'And the agreement of the Companions that it is the last hour on Friday has been authentically reported, so it is not allowed to oppose them.'"⁴
