Shaykh Al-Albaanee: The sunnah in the takbeer [of 'Eed] differs from the prevailing sunnah in matters of adhkaar, the general sunnah in matters of adhkaar is for the dhikr to be done quietly and not out loud, but there are times where this sunnah is not the case and where saying it out loud is what is legislated: the takbeers of 'Eed are of this type ... the takbeers of 'Eed al-Adhaa are said out loud and not quietly.
